



Old English lemon oil






Steel wool






Cleaning and maintaining your solid wood desktop

- Clear the area of your desk you wish to clean or touch up.
- Shake the bottle of lemon oil well and, using a clean cloth, apply it to the surface along the grain of the wood.
- Using a clean polishing cloth, remove any excess oil by wiping the surface until the wood is dry.



For more thorough care:

- For more significant imperfections (light scratches, scuffing, light staining), use the steel wool hand pad to lightly buff out the imperfection.
- When the imperfection is no longer visible, remove as much dust as possible with a soft cloth, then apply lemon oil as directed above.



For scratch repair:

- Clear the area of your desk you wish to clean or touch up.
- Apply scratch cover to a clean cloth, then wipe the scratched area
 of the desk and continue wiping with the cloth until the area is dry.
 Light scratches do not need to be buffed out first, while deeper
 scratches may need to be buffed out with steel wool before applying scratch cover.
- Shake the bottle of lemon oil well and, using a clean cloth, apply it to the surface along the grain of the wood.
- Using a clean polishing cloth, remove any excess oil by wiping the surface until the wood is dry.
