What exactly does this mean? Our desktops have been rigorously tested by an independent third party laboratory under strictconditions to evaluate chemical emissions. To earn the GREENGUARD certification, materials must meet requirements set by all of the following:

- ASTM Standards D-5116 and D-6670
- US Environmental Protection Agency's (USEPA) testing protocol for furniture
- State of Washington's protocol for interior furnishings and construction materials
- Germany's Blue Angel Program
- California's Department of Public Health Services (CDPH)
- Standard Practice for Specification Section 01350
- ISO 16000 environmental testing series

Products are tested in an environment that closely resembles actual use, and all standards and testing methods are publicly available. GREENGUARD certification shows that a product is safe for indoor use, with no concerns about chemical emissions such as formaldehyde, often found in lower-quality laminates. GREENGUARD certification is recognized by building programs around the world, including the US Green Building Council, Green Seal, and Green Guide for Health Care. The certification is your assurance that our products are sustainable and safe.
